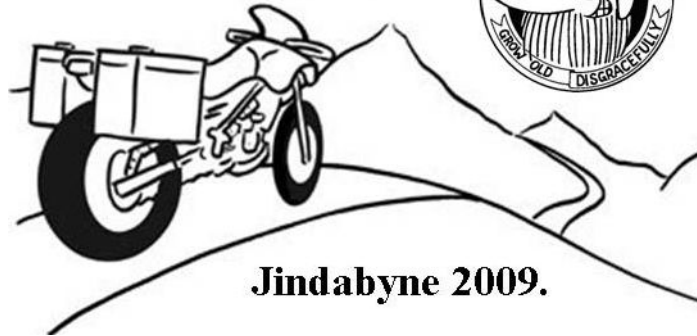

**19<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER ODYSSEY**

***Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2009***

**JINDABYNE N . S . W .**

Jindabyne (S36 24.954 E148 37.446) is a new town created after the original settlement was drowned by the Snowy Mountains Hydro-electricity Authority in the late 1960s. Nestled at the end of Lake Jindabyne (which was completed in 1967 and has a capacity of 689 790 ML) modern day Jindabyne owes its continuing existence to its proximity to the major ski resorts Thredbo and Perisher Blue in the Snowy Mountains and the superb facilities it offers to trout fishermen. Located 61 km from Cooma and 462 km from Sydney it is 991 metres above sea level.

The venue for **ALL** of the Odyssey functions will be at the Jindabyne Bowling & Sports Club at Bay Street Jindabyne (<http://www.jindabynebowlingclub.com.au/>).

- On Friday evening there will be a BBQ starting at 7.30 pm.
- A hot and cold breakfast will be served on Saturday morning from 7.30 to 9.00am.
- A three-course Odyssey dinner will be served on Saturday night starting at 7.30pm.

We will have a short and a long ride arranged for Saturday, more on this closer to the Odyssey.

There is a large selection of accommodation in Jindabyne and surrounding areas. However, we have secured a great deal with 4 Alpine lodges in Gippsland Street Jindabyne for Ulysses members attending the Odyssey. The Committee strongly recommend that you form up into groups and take advantage of the deal we have negotiated with these lodges. (***See the attached Accommodation Information Sheet for further details.***)

Shuttle bus transport will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights (both ways) picking up and dropping off at the Blizzard Bunny Ski Lodge 43 Gippsland Street Jindabyne. Friday night pickup will commence at 6:30 pm from the Blizzard Bunny Ski Lodge with the last pick up at 7:30 pm. The return trips from the Jindabyne Bowling & Sport Club will commence at 10:00 pm and continue until all members have been returned to the lodges. On Saturday night the shuttle bus will commence transporting Odyssey goers from the Blizzard Bunny Ski Lodge commencing at 6:30 pm. Again the last bus will leave at 7:30 pm. The return trips from the Bowling & Sports Club will commence at 10:00 pm. Those wishing to 'kick on' can do so as there is a reliable taxi service (Snowy Mountains Taxi Service 6457 2444)..

**Note:** The bus **WILL NOT** be picking up or dropping off other than the arranged route from the Blizzard Bunny Ski Lodge to the Bowling & Sports Club and return journeys. If you decide to stay at a location other than the Alpine Lodges in Gippsland Street Jindabyne then you will have to make your own way to the Friday night BBQ and the Saturday night dinner.

**There are 2 (only) packages available:**

- **Package 1** – This includes Friday night BBQ, Saturday morning breakfast and the Odyssey dinner on Saturday night – **Cost \$80 per person**
- **Package 2** – Saturday night Odyssey dinner only – **Cost \$40 per person**

(Both packages include 19<sup>th</sup> October Odyssey badge and *shuttle bus transport as above*)

**NOTE:** **REGISTRATIONS CLOSE** Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2009. A late fee of \$10.00 per person will be charged for late registrations.

### **Eligibility to attend the Odyssey**

The Odyssey is open to the following:

- Financial members of the Ulysses Club Inc ('Financial member').
- The immediate partner of a financial member ('Partner') attending the Odyssey.
- A person ('Guest') who is not a Financial member but who is eligible for membership in the Ulysses Club Inc and who has been invited by and is accompanying a Financial member who is attending the Odyssey.
- A Financial member may only invite one (1) Guest to the Odyssey. For clarification, if a financial member and their immediate partner are both attending the Odyssey then the financial member may also invite one Guest. All Guests attending the Odyssey are the responsibility of the financial member who has invited them.

***There are no exceptions to the above, under any circumstances – the Committee reserve the right to refuse members and/or their guests Odyssey registration.***
